This Circular Instruction is served to advise that **Friday 15th September, 2023 has been declared as a Public Holiday throughout Papua New Guinea to celebrate the forty-eight (48th) Independence Day**, as confirmed in the National Gazette No. 775 of 2022 and Circular Instruction No. 18 of 2022 on Public Holidays for 2023.

From the 1st of September, 2023, you are urged to decorate your Office Buildings in Red, Black & Gold colours, leading up to the Independence Day celebrations. Public Servants in the Nation's Capital are encouraged to attend the following events on Saturday 16th of September, 2023;
