Purpose:

The purpose of the role is to control the Conservation & Environment Protection Authority to fulfill the Government's approved Mission and Functional Statements imposed by the Constitution and relevant legislations in accordance with policy directives and priorities of the National Executive Council as conveyed by the Minister for Environment Conservation and Climate Change.

Accountabilities:

The Managing Director will be accountable for the following:

- Provision of sound, informed, and accurate advice on Conservation Environment Protection matters to the Minister and NEC under the requirements imposed by Law.
- 2) Effective and efficient operation of the Conservation Environment Protection Authority to fulfill the Government's environmental, conservation and economic objectives through sound strategic planning and leadership.
- 3) Effective participation in the global environmental treaties and conservations in order to maximize international funding contributions to the sustainable development of the economy and the Nation.
- 4) Achievement of specific annual performance targets set by the Minister from time to time in accordance with Governments priorities.

Major Duties:

- 1) Ensure that all strategic plans and performance objectives of the organization are in compliance with the overall policy directives and priorities of the Government as communicated from time to time by the CACC.
- 2) Ensure all organization's operations and development objectives are determined in strict compliance with the Conservation Environment Protection Authority legislation in place from time to time.
- 3) Ensure all funds and assets provided to the organization are used in accordance with the relevant provisions of the *Public Finance (Management) Act*.
- 4) Ensure all personnel are supervised and managed in accordance with the relevant provisions of the *Public Services (Management) Act*.
- 5) Provide strategic guidance and leadership in daily operation of the Organization.
- 6) Ensure implementation and development of appropriate policies on various environmental and conservation issues in the best interest of the Nation.
- 7) Provide policy and technical advice to the Minister and NEC on a regular basis as required by the Minister.

- 9) Represents the organization on various Boards and Committees as required by various legislations.
- 10) Perform other duties consistent with the above and as directed by the Minister and or NEC.

Selection Criteria:

Skills and Knowledge:

1) Vast knowledge and understanding of the environment and regulatory industry.

The successful candidate must have:

- Strong track record of liaison and negotiation skills between industry and other stakeholders.
