SUBJECT: OBSERVATION OF THE 20 DAYS OF HUMAN RIGHTS ACTIVISM CAMPAIGN FROM THE 20TH NOVEMBER – 10TH OF DECEMBER, 2025

This Circular Instruction serves to inform all Departmental Heads, Provincial Administrators and Heads of Agencies on the observation and commemoration of the annual **20 Days of Human Rights Activism Campaign** in the public service that commences on the 20th of November and ends on 10th of December 2025.

The Official Launching of the 20 Days of Human Rights Activism Campaign

The "20 Days of Human Rights Activism Campaign" (20 DHRAC) in Papua New Guinea is part of the global movement that began with the "16 Days of Activism Against Gender- Based Violence". In 2008, the United Nations Secretary-General in support of this initiative, launched the campaign - UNITE by 2030 to End Violence against Women and runs parallel to the 16 Days of Activism.

The 20 Days of the Human Rights Activism Campaign in the National Public Service is delivered through its various GESI Help Desks through the Public Service Male Advocacy Network (PS MAN). The PS MAN work in solidarity towards the prevention and elimination of violence against women and girls in the workplace, homes and communities.

launch this year's campaign on Thursday, 20th of November in Mt. Hagen in partnership with the Western Highlands Provincial Government.

The launch will be witnessed by representatives from the political arena, government agencies, Civil Society Organisations (CSOs), Non – Government Organisation (NGOs), Faith- Based Organisations (FBOs) and individuals.

This year's 20 DHRAC Theme

The UNITE Campaign annually focuses on a specific theme and this year's **international theme is "UNITE to End Digital Violence against All Women and Girls."** This theme focuses on combating online violence and harassment through government legislation intervention, tech company accountability and promoting safer digital spaces.

While the national theme remains the same as last year's as "It's My Responsibility - Let's Work Together to Prevent All Forms of Violence."

This is an individual call to action that emphasizes the need for personal ownership and accountability in ensuring that safe cyber practices are applied in the dissemination of digital information and in the use of online platforms.

In addressing the rise of digital violence against women and girls, let us all raise our voices and work in collaboration to create cyber safety awareness in our families, communities and workplaces.
